There is an airport at Ballina 10 minutes to the south and an international airport at Coolangatta, one hour to the north. A bus stop is at the top of the street. There is a large K-12 Catholic school nearby and many public primary and high schools.

Located on the northern edge of the village is Lake Ainsworth, a fresh water lake that has distinctive tannin-stained waters from the surrounding tea trees and is in stunning contrast with the white sands of Seven Mile beach. The headland is popular with surfers and is a great spot to watch the dolphins and locals surfing and the annual whale migration.
