Charity of the Month

USF Endowment for Marine Sciences

For twenty years, Tampa Bay Parrot Heads have offered an endowment fellowship to a graduate student enrolled in a graduate program who have an interest in environmental issues in and around Tampa Bay.

This year's recipient is Shuangling Chen. She is studying Optical Oceanography. Using satellites and algorithms she developed, she is able to map large areas (think Gulf of Mexico) for atmospheric carbon dioxide saturation of the ocean surface. More CO2, more ocean acidification. Not good. Currently there is shipboard measurements, but that is limited to time and space.

THE SECOND TIME I MET JIM MORRIS, “THE MAN WHO MADE PLAID TROPICAL”

ONE NEVER GETS A SECOND CHANCE FOR A FIRST IMPRESSION, AN OLD SAYING THAT SORTA RINGS TRUE. BUT NOT ALWAYS TRUE. A FEW YEARS BACK WHEN I BEGAN MY TRANSFORMATION FROM A FULL TIME WORKAHOLIC TO A PART TIME PARROTHEAD I HAD A FIRST IMPRESSION OF TWO MUSICIANS WHO AT THE TIME DIDN'T IMPRESS, IN FACT THEY HAD A TERRIBLE TIME EVEN GETTING STARTED. I FIRST SAW JIM AT AN ORLANDO PARROTHEAD CLUB CONCERT AFTER A MINOR LEAGUE BASEBALL GAME. JAMES WHITE AND JIM MORRIS AND THE MORRIS GUY COULDN'T GET HIS GUITAR HOT, AND IT TOOK FOREVER TO FIGURE OUT THE ISSUE, A PLUG NOT PLUGGED IN TO ITS PROPER LOCATION. I CAN REMEMBER ONLY ONE SONG THAT THEY PLAYED THAT HOT AFTERNOON AND IT WASN'T A BUFFET SONG, IT WASN'T A TROPICAL SONG, HELL IT WASN'T EVEN ONE OF THEIR SONGS. IT WAS A SONG THAT I HAD HEARD GROWING UP AS A KID, A POPULAR SONG FROM MY PARENTS GENERATION, A SONG THAT WHEN IT PLAYED ON THE RADIO, I WOULD TURN THE DIAL. A COUNTRY SONG SUNG BY MARTY ROBBINS, EL PASO. I MADE A VOW, NEVER TO GO OUT OF MY WAY TO HEAR THESE TWO ARTISTS EVER AGAIN. ESPECIALLY THAT MORRIS GUY, WHO COULDN'T EVEN PLUG HIS INSTRUMENT INTO THE RIGHT HOLE. END OF THE STORY OR SO I THOUGHT, NEVER WOULD OUR PATHS CROSS AGAIN. BOY WAS I WRONG, (continued on next page...)



AND IT HAPPENED IN A WAY THAT WAS JUST THE OPPOSITE OF OUR FIRST MEETING AT THAT BALL FIELD IN ORLANDO WITH A CROWD OF MAYBE 50, TO THE CASA IN KEY WEST ON THE BIG STAGE WITH THOUSANDS. THERE ARE NOT MANY PERFORMERS WHO'S MUSIC CAN AT FIRST PLAYING CAN MAKE YOU A FAN, AND I WAS HOOKED. HE HAD THE CROWD DANCING TO HIS TUNES AND SINGING HIS LYRICS, A NIGHT THAT IS STILL FRESH IN MY MEMORY. I WANTED TO BUY HIS MUSIC, ESPECIALLY THE ONE THAT HAD "MIKE" ON IT. SO OVER TO THE MERCHANDISE TABLE WHERE I WAS INFORMED THAT THEY HAD SOLD OUT OF MIKE, WHICH WAS JUST A ONE SONG C/D, SO I ASKED WHICH ONE OF THE PLETHORA OF C/D ON THE TABLE SHOULD I BUY FIRST, SINCE THERE WAS TOO MANY TO BUY ALL OF THEM AT ONCE, AND I DIDN'T WANT TO DEplete MY BEER MONEY. SO I ASKED FOR ADVICE ON WHICH C/D TO BUY, "LAID BACK AND KEY WASTED " SHE SAID WAS A GOOD PLACE TO START, AND THATS WHEN I REALIZED THAT IT WAS THE MORRIS GUY I SWORE I NEVER WANTED TO HEAR AGAIN. AND MUCH LATTER THAT THE ATTRACTIVE YOUNG SALES GIRL WAS HIS WIFE SHARON.

SO LIKE MANY WHO FOLLOW THE MUSIC OF THE ENTIRE TROP ROCK ARTIST, I BEGAN TO TRY TO LIVE THE LIFE THAT THEY ALL SANG ABOUT. AND I STARTED SEEING THAT MORRIS GUY PERFORM EVERY CHANCE THAT I COULD. I COULDN' WAIT TO SEE JIM AT THE NAV-A-GATOR AND AT BURNT STORE AND AT BERTS AND AT THE TWISTED CONCH AND THE SOUTH BEACH BAR AND GRILLE AND EVERY OTHER PLACE THAT HE PLAYED AT. I HAD A FAVORITE SONG, "WORKING AT THE PALM TREE FARM ", AND I LOVED THAT SONG TILL I HEARD MY FAVORITE SONG EVER,"HE SAID SO LONG". THAT SONG WAS ME, AND I TOOK IT TO HEART, THE LYRICS ARE SO TRUE FOR ME. HAVING A DAUGHTER LIVING IN ALASKA AND HAVING SPENT TIME IN MOOSE POINT AND DRIVING TO THE END OF THE ROAD TO HOMER, FLYING OUT OF TALKEETNA AND LANDING ON A GLACIER AT THE FOOT OF MT. DENALI. AND THE LYRICS THAT JIM WROTE, "SOME FOCUS ON A SHAKY DREAM SOME 40 YEARS AWAY " HIT ME HARD. I WASN'T LIVING FOR THE NOW, I WASN'T EVEN LIVING. SO I CHANGED, AND ALONG THE WAY I BECAME FRIENDS WITH JIM, A LOW MAINTENANCE FRIEND, VERY LOW.

WE HAD A LOT OF GOOD TIMES, AND ALONG THE WAY HE GAVE ME THE TAG CRAZY MARK, WHICH COULD BE AN INSULT TO CRAZY PEOPLE. AND HE GAVE ME A LOT OF ADVICE, EVEN WHEN I DIDN'T KNOW THAT I HAD ASKED FOR ANY. I TOLD JIM I WASN'T A FAN, I WAS A CONSUMER, AND HIS MUSIC WAS A PRODUCT THAT I CHOSE TO PURCHASE. MY LIFE CERTAINLY CHANGED, I QUIT WEARING THE COMPANY ATTIRE, WORE A DIFFERENT TROPICAL SHIRT EVERY DAY, DECK SHOES ONLY, THREW AWAY ALL MY SOCKS AND STARTED WORKING HARD ON A LAID BACK ATTITUDE. EVEN MY BACK YARD STARTED TO EVOLVE A TROPICAL LOOK WHEN I RETIRED IN 2007. SLOW AT FIRST, AND THEN ALL HELL BROKE LOOSE. EVEN MY SON NOTICED AND CALLED TO GIVE ME ADVICE,"QUIT BUILDING DAD, YOU ARE SPENDING MY INHERITANCE ". SO IN WENT A STAGE, ANOTHER STAGE, A SKYBOX, MEN AND WOMEN BATHROOMS, BUNKHOUSE (AKA) GREEN ROOM, THE YARDOME. IT AMUSED JIM, AND HE ALWAYS HAD A COMMENT ON WHAT WAS NEW, AND SUGGESTIONS ON WHAT TO BUILD NEXT. AND ALONG THE WAY JIM COINED THE NAME OF MY VENUE, "THE YARD", AND MY WIFE AGREED SO WE BECAME "THE YARD". AND WE OPENED UP THE YARD TO ALL TYPES OF TROP ROCK MUSIC AND THE ARTIST THAT PLAY THE GENRE. AND WHEN I LOOK BACK ON HOW I GOT HERE ALL THE ROADS LEADS ALL THE WAY BACK TO THAT MORRIS GUY AND THE SONGS THAT CHANGED MY LIFE. FROM THE NAV-A-GATOR, THE TWISTED CONCH, FARLONS ON THE WATER, SOUTH BEACH BAR AND GRILLE, THE CONCH HOUSE LOUNGE, THE WHITE ELEPHANT, BORA BORA, TAHITI, THE PAUL GAUGUIN. TO USE HIS WORDS, "IT'S REALLY BEEN ONE INCREDIBLE JOURNEY, SEARCHING MY LIFE FOR A SONG. IF YOU LOVE WIDE OPEN SPACES AND TROPICAL PLACES, I'M HAPPY TO TAKE YOU ALONG ". JIM MORRIS --- AND HE DID. YOU SANG AND TALKED ABOUT THAT BOOK YOU WERE GOING TO WRITE AND I ALWAYS ASKED HOW THE WRITER GUY WAS DOING, ESPECIALLY AFTER YOU TOLD ME OF YOUR CONVERSATIONS WITH YOUR WRITER FRIENDS, AND HOW THEY ENCOURAGED YOU TO WRITE. HOW THEY POINTED OUT THAT THEY WROTE THOUSANDS OF WORDS TO TELL THEIR HERO'S TALE, BUT YOU ACCOMPLISHED THE EXACT SAME STORY LINES IN A 3-1/2 MINUTE SONG, AND EVEN MADE IT RHYME. AND LIKE NOT SEEING THE FOREST FOR ALL THE TREES, NOW I CAN SEE YOU DID WRITE THAT BOOK, AND ITS IN YOUR SONGS, AND ALL ONE HAS TO DO, IS STRING THEM TOGETHER IN THE CORRECT ORDER. GONNA BE A LOT MORE THAN ONE BOOK. THE MONTANA SONGS ALONE ARE AT LEAST THREE BOOKS. A BOOK CASE FULL, IN 3-1/2 MINUTE CHAPTERS. NOW I REALIZE THAT YOU DID WRITE THAT NOVEL AND IT WILL BE A # 1 BEST SELLER. THANK YOU JIM. OVER ALL THESE YEARS YOU HAVE GIVEN US MORE THAN ANYTHING WE GAVE TO YOU. AND THESE WORDS I HAVE WRITTEN ARE NOT MINE ALONE, BUT ARE THE WORDS OF ALL THE THOUSANDS OF THE PEOPLE THAT YOU HAVE ENTERTAINED IN YOUR TRAVELS. ALL YOUR FANS BECAME YOUR FRIENDS, AND WE ALL HAVE OUR FAVORITE SONGS, AND STORIES TO TELL, AND MEMORIES THAT WILL NEVER FADE. YOU WERE SO DAMN PROLIFIC, LIKE A CLOCK WORK, A NEW C/D NEARLY EVERY YEAR. A RARE TALENT. WE ALL FEEL THE LOSS IN MANY WAYS, WE ALL WILL COPE IN DIFFERENT WAYS, AND WE ALL HAVE YOUR MUSIC. JIM HAD FRIENDS, NOT FANS. ONE HAD TO MEET JIM HALFWAY, AS HE WAS A LITTLE SHY, AND AS A ROCK STAR THAT WAS UNUSUAL. TO MEN HE WAS ALL THAT WE WANTED TO BE, TO WOMEN HE WAS WHAT THEY WANTED ALL MEN TO BE. BUT WE ALL LOST A FRIEND, WHO ALWAYS HAD A WORD OF WELCOME THAT CAME WITH A SMILE. SOME FRIENDS SAW JIM ALMOST EVERY WEEK, SOME SAW JIM ONLY ONCE A YEAR, BUT WE ALL LOVED THE GUY WITH THE BLUE GUITAR CASE. "LEARN TO PLAY THE GUITAR SON, YOU'LL ALWAYS HAVE A FRIEND" THANKS JIM, YOU DID AND YOU DID SHOWED US A WAY. PUT IN A GOOD WORD FOR ALL OF US TO THE "COSMIC MAGICIAN" AND TELL HIM "THANKS FOR ALL THE BEER"

YOU WERE OUR FRIEND, WHO JUST HAPPENED TO PLAY THE MUSIC THAT WE LOVED.

What Is A Parrot Head????

A Parrot head is a fan of Jimmy Buffett's music. They like the things Jimmy sings about. They like to phlock together in a tropical life style. When Jimmy Buffet comes to town to do a concert parking lots look like beaches with tiki huts and plenty of adult libation. Parrot Heads Indeed!!!!!!

Where did the name Parrot Head come from??

During a concert, Jimmy Buffett commented on the tropical type clothes and hats the fans wore and how they were as loyal as The Dead Heads. It was then that a member of the Coral Reefer Band, Timothy B. Schmit, coined the phrase Parrot Heads. He went on to join The Eagles.
