- GPS: N274862 W822641
 - Approx 2 miles NW of Apollo Beach
 - Approx 2 miles SW of Alafia River
 - Approx 2 miles SE of MacDill AFB
 - Approx 3 miles S of Davis Island
 - Approx 2 miles West from the Big Bend Power Plant. Use power plant's smoke stacks to guide on
- Boat Ramps: *\$5 Ramp Fee
 - *Alafia River: (1) Williams Park (US-41) & (2) Riverview Community Park (E. US-301)
 - Davis Island (FREE) next to Yacht Club
- Phlock to the southeast side of the island, Look for TBPH & TBPH Navy Flags.

TIME: 10am to 6pm (Sunset, 8:28 pm); Tides: High: 9:22 am, Low: 3:38 pm

WHAT TO BRING: Side dish to share (per boat), beach shoes, BYOB, canopy/umbrella for shade, "floaties", chairs, beach gear/sunblock, garbage/trash bags, a couple of bucks to tip our musical guest, Rich "Schooner" McGuire, who will play some tunes for us.
