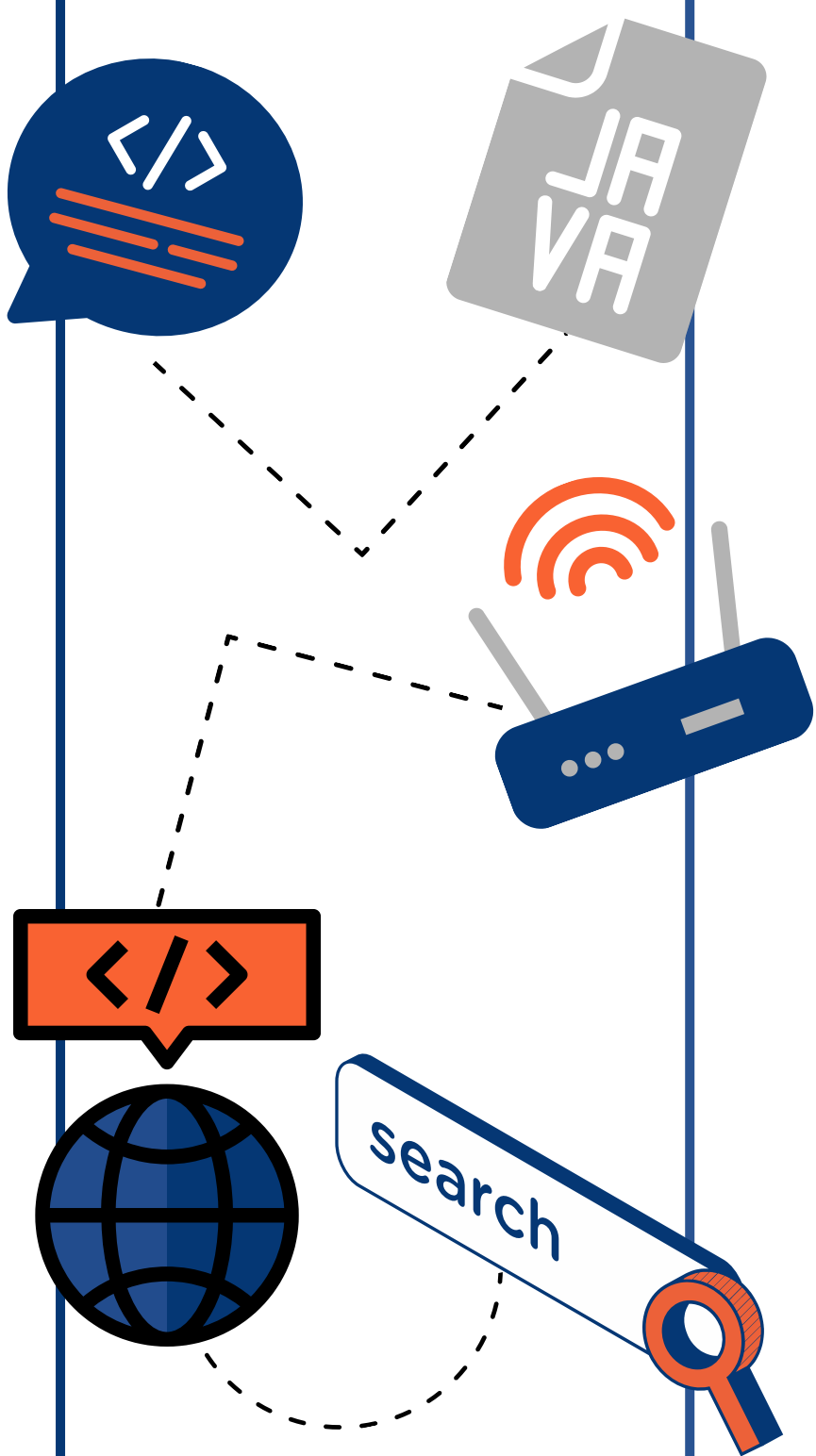

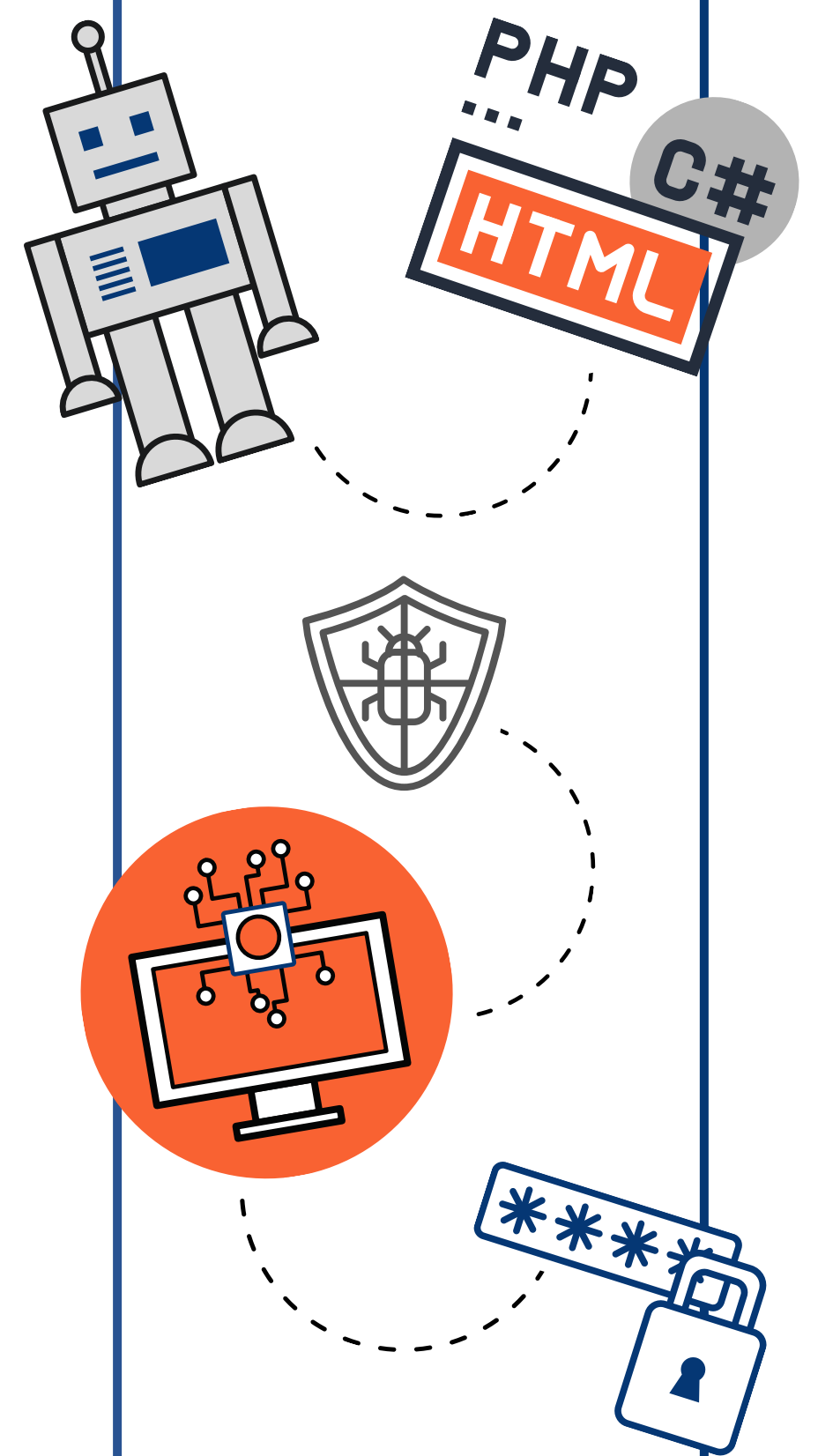
You are challenged to identify an issue and propose a computing solution that embraces the theme of
