





Useless But Important Information

As Requested - More History Lessons, Soooooo Here Ya Go . . .

During that same summer trip in 1994 to Key West that Sarah Klatt (Sarah Sunshine) and I took before the first Tampa Bay Parrot Heads in Paradise Club (TBPHC) meeting where we met Capt. Tony for the first time, one of the cool ideas we took from there was the Teeeeeeeeaaaaaaaammmmmm Drink. I don't remember exactly which bar we were at on Duval Street. I believe it was either at Sloppy Joe's or the small one at Ricks.

Nevertheless, this awesome piano playin entertainer would stop in the middle of his set every once in a while and simply ask everyone to raise their glasses and he would say "It's time for a team drink!" I liked that and when we started the club, I started using it. It evolved into a story which I created to honor people.

I'm not sure how it's used today, but in the early years I would say, "Raise your glasses up high" and then tell the following story. "Now back in the days when shipwrecks would constantly occur off of Key West, the pirates would go out to the reefs and plunder and pillage all that they could gather from these sinking ships. They would then come back to Capt. Tony's a Saloon and all celebrate their collective booty together by raising their rum glasses up high in the air and the Captain would say, 'In your honor, what time is it?' And all the pirates would respond as loud as they could, "It's time for team drink!" And then I would add, "So to all of you members of the Tampa Bay Parrot Heads in Paradise Club, in YOUR honor, what time is it?" And all would respond loudly,

"It's time for a team drink".

The toast evolved into shorter versions without the descriptive history lesson of the pirates - which was something I simply created as historical fiction because, well, piracy in the Keys mainly occurred back in the 1800's when Key West was the wealthiest city per capita in the United States. Thus, Capt. Tony's Saloon and Capt. Tony certainly were not around quite yet.

Anyway, as we in the TBPHC went to national Parrot Head conventions, of course we would constantly offer very loud Team Drink toasts in which the names stretched out to Teeeeeeeeeeaaaaaaammmmmmmm Drink and "arrrrrrggghhhhhhhhh" or "woooooooooooo" was added to the end of the toast. In fact, when the TBPHC ran one of the early national conventions in New Orleans I said it so much on stage that it took a life of its own and made its way around the country since their were clubs from many states there.
