Again, Tampa Bay Watch, wants to extend our appreciation for your ongoing support. The gift of \$2,400 from the Tampa Bay Parrot Heads will continue to help our restoration efforts for our habitat. Currently, we have been installing oyster domes at McKay Bay and this week will be at MacDill Airforce Base. It takes a lot of dollars and manpower (each dome weighs 220 lbs.). These oyster domes will create a barrier to prevent shore erosion as well as filter the water. One oyster can filter 2 to 10 gallons of water in one hour! By protecting our estuary, we enjoy the production of marine life so...




