Robert Keyth has been in the music business for more than 30 years. He grew up in Illinois and began his career in Chicago playing with many different show bands including The Buckingham's, Freda Payne, Dave Major and the Minors, and The Linda Merrill Show. He later moved to Tampa, FL where he was in several successful bands such as the "Just Us Brothers Band" and "Robert Keyth and the Sand Band." The Sand Band became so popular that he was convinced to move to Nashville, TN and seek out a recording contract. There he became a successful songwriter, writing songs for many artists including B.J. Thomas and Stonewall Jackson. He plays as many as nine instruments in one show and has been called the "One Man Jam" because of his ability to be so diverse all by himself.

Sassy has been singing since she was three years old. She grew up right outside of Nashville, TN and spent most of her childhood getting her name known throughout the area. She appeared on many local radio and television stations and learned to play piano, guitar, and bass, all before she was 12! By the time she was 17, she had traveled with multiple bands and even opened for John Michael Montgomery in Panama City Beach, FL. At the same time, she went to school and majored in Music Theory while maintaining a 4.0 GPA. Some people have called her "Leather Lungs" and "The Yodeler" because of her powerful alto voice and ability to sing anything. While she grew up listening to



traditional country and has a passion for it, she is also an excellent classic rock and blues singer. She regularly plays a fretless bass in her shows at the same time, too!

Florida Parrot Rescue

Help support the Florida Parrot Rescue in August at the 12th Annual Bar Stroll in Maderia Beach.

Florida Parrot Rescue works throughout the entire state of Florida, and is a 501c3 non-profit, all volunteer run, avian rescue dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and placement of companion parrots. We understand that all parrot owners love their birds, and that finding a new home for their birds is used as a last option. Florida Parrot Rescue remains non-judgmental and supportive in your time of need. If you need to re-home your bird, Florida Parrot Rescue can help by offering your bird a safe place to stay and get veterinary care until the right home can be found!

All of our birds have been to one of the many avian veterinarians we use across the state of Florida. Each bird – regardless of size or species – has been given a full well bird check with either a full physical with a fecal gram stain and cultures or a physical with blood work (or both – this is determined by the veterinarian). Some birds have multiple veterinarian visits before they are placed up for adoption (depending on any health issues which need to be resolved before being cleared for adoption by the veterinarian). Any dogs or cats we have available for adoption will be spayed/neutered, up to date on vaccinations, and on flea and heart worm medications.



Please be aware that adopting a bird is a lifelong responsibility, as many birds out-live their owners. We take special care in matching up our adoptable birds with the right owners to build lasting relationships and forever homes. Florida Parrot Rescue is licensed with the state of Florida as a non-profit and has attained 501c3 tax exempt status.

If you are not sure if having a parrot in your life is for you, or you would like to learn more about parrots, please check out our education section and also watch the PBS documentary Parrot Confidential to learn more about the plight of parrots in captivity. You can also read about Parrot Conservation in the New World by Nigel Collar and about Dimensions and Causes of the Parrot Conservation Crisis by N.J. Collar and A.T. Juniper.

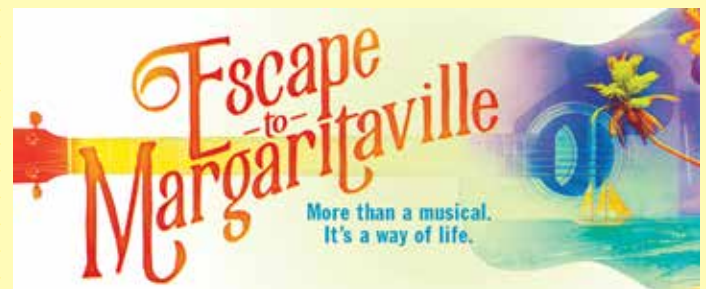
Huey Lewis cancels 2018 Tour Due to Hearing Loss

Huey Lewis and The News have cancelled all of their 2018 performances including shows that were scheduled with **Jimmy Buffett and the Coral Reefer Band** at Fenway Park in Boston on August 9th and the MGM Grand Arena in Las Vegas on October 20th.

Announcement from Huey Lewis:

"Two and a half months ago, just before a show in Dallas, I lost most of my hearing. Although I can still hear a little, one on one, and on the phone, I can't hear music well enough to sing. The lower frequencies distort violently making it impossible to find pitch. I've been to the House Ear Institute, the Stanford Ear Institute, and the Mayo Clinic, hoping to find an answer. The doctors believe I have Meniere's disease and have agreed that I can't perform until I improve. Therefore the only prudent thing to do is to cancel all future shows. Needless to say, I feel horrible about this, and wish to sincerely apologize to all the fans who've already bought tickets and were planning to come see us. I'm going to concentrate on getting better, and hope that one day soon I'll be able to perform again."

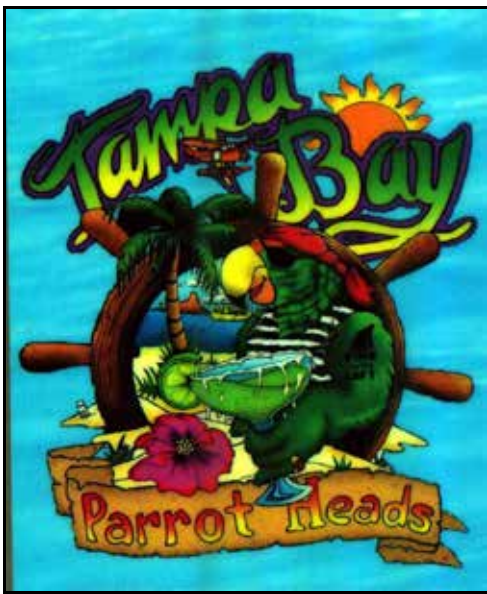
