From garage bands in High School to a career in broadcasting, TJ Walsh has been entertaining crowds for decades. He is at home on the radio as he was in front of the television camera or on the theatrical stage.

The last 30 plus years he has

returned to his first love, playing and writing music. In the 90's he discovered the phenomenon created by the music of Jimmy Buffett and began playing to Parrothead groups from Chicago to Key West. Making his home in the Myrtle Beach area, he was the first entertainer hired to play the new Margaritaville and spent 5 years playing 156 evenings a week before Tommy Bahama lured him into their comfortable upscale restaurant to perform 5 days a week for another 5 years. During this time with both chains he found the time to perform for pre-concert Jimmy Buffett shows in Columbia, SC along with fundraisers, clubs and private functions throughout North Carolina, South Carolina and Georgia.

The last 15 years has found him performing from Key West Florida to South Carolina and beyond promoting his original songs like the number 1 song "I Wanna Be Like Jimmy Buffett", a song we have been told got the attention of Jimmy himself as he mentioned it in a television network interview. His music has been nominated as well for the coveted Cammy Award and is being played to audiences on Radio AIA, iHeart Radio and AM and FM stations throughout the eastern half of the country and worldwide. His down home humor will keep you amused and his songs will make you smile. TJ has never played a venue that did not ask him for a return performance and that says everything.





As we continue to refine the schedule for Music on the Bay,

we can let you know that Thursday from 4-6pm "Jeff & The Camaros" will be playing for us. Originally from Georgia but now living near Panama City, Florida, Jeff Brewer is no stranger to the Trop Rock world with his infectious enthusiasm



involving the crowd while playing. You may recall being handed a mustache to wear while he plays and sings JB's "Pencil Thin Mustache". Jeff is a great addition to our line up!



Directly following will be Brent Burns from 6-8pm. Brent is from Gulf Shores, Alabama and has won several TRMA awards going all the way back to the beginning in 2008 and many since then. A war vet and Purple Heart recipient, he was the first American entertainer to perform for troops overseas after the tragedy of Sept 11th. You may recognize one of his songs

played on many of the trop rock radio stations, "I've Got a Beach in My Backyard".

Finishing out the evening on Thursday is none other than Jerry Diaz & Hanna's Reef from 8-10pm. A "Gulf Coast Beach Band" from Galveston, Texas, the band plays their brand of "fun in the sun" with a luau atmosphere on stage. You'll hear tropical elements of steel drums and Latin percussion with the driving beat of rock and roll.






