



TBPH Fellowship Award



Dear Parrot Head Club Members,

I'd like to thank all of the club members for their recent contribution to the Tampa Bay Parrot Head Fellowship Award at the USF College of Marine Science in St. Petersburg. This award was established as an endowed fund for students enrolled in our graduate program who have an interest in environmental issues in and around Tampa Bay. This year's award winner, Garrett Miller, is a Master's student Marine Resource Assessment, whose work is in the area of fish ecology. I'm pleased to share with you a few interesting facts about The USF College of Marine Science in St. Petersburg.

- Our scientists work in every ocean on issues of global and regional relevance, with research strengths including sustainable fisheries, red tides, coral reef health, sea level rise, and coastal flooding, to name a few.
- In the 50 years since its official beginning, CMS has expanded in size and capability to become an internationally recognized leader in ocean science and graduate education.
- We have 26 faculty, ~100 graduate students, and about 100 technical and administrative staff. CMS researchers secure ~\$15M in annual research expenditures.
- Our generous donors have helped us to build a \$20M fellowship endowment which provides around \$408,000 annually to 29 CMS graduate students.
- Our graduate students earn many other competitive graduate fellowships, travel grants and recognition of research excellence at national and international meetings.
- Last year, our students secured more than \$346,000 in external research funding.

We could not do our work without our community partners and donors, and we want to thank you for your generosity in establishing the Tampa Bay Parrot Head Fellowship in Marine Science.



<u>Jack Mosley</u>

Jack Mosley, originally from Panama City Florida, is considered by many to be one of the best "TropRock" song writers and entertainers in the country. As an entertainer, Jack has performed all over the United States and the Caribbean and has opened shows for artist such as Johnny Cash, Tanya Tucker, Phil Vassar, The Warren Brothers, and Bad Company to name a few.

With his CD's being played on radiomargaritaville.com, jimmydreamz.com and almost all of the other TropRock radio stations (both internet, satellite and standard FM), and performing shows from Key West to Michigan, he has firmly established himself as a major force in TropRock music.

Jack is also a co-producer for an annual "TropRock" event



in Pigeon Forge TN called TropRocks the Smokies. At this event, Jack brings in the best TropRock artist from around the country to perform their music in a theater setting with a backing band made up of some of the finest musicians Tennessee has to offer.

THURSDAY Eric Erdman

If it's true that an artist's job is to captivate us for however long they have asked for our attention, no one has looked away from Eric Erdman since he first took the stage to front a band. Maybe that is because there is nothing between Eric and his audience, between Eric and the world. He lets it all in and what comes back is a poet's soul in a troubadour's voice.



Face to face with the crowds, singing of the challenges facing the youth, the country, and the heartbroken have fueled four albums, constant gigging that included three international USO tours, and only seared in Eric's need to write about what he sees, what he feels. He's penned a theme song for a nationally televised show, produced every genre from big band to country because you can't pigeonhole a true artist. He hears what a song should sound like before it's really a song. Actor Bruce Greenwood speaks of Eric's inspiration that makes the musicians on his projects "as emotionally involved" as he is, his guitar work, "stunning and specific" pulling the listener "inside the song".

His new record gives us something to think about and something to feel. While that's not unusual from an Eric Erdman project, it does seem to have brought together everything he does and knows well, offering us even deeper insight into ourselves and others and Eric.

Robin is a passionate songwriter, Ukulele lover, and musical chameleon. Writing about everything from beaches to love triangles. She finds song ideas within her ordinary life, and sends them off into the world to be listened to.

getting Radio Airplay all around the world, and making people dance in their bathing suits! Now a thriving singer songwriter, Robin is on the "Ones to Watch" list for the Nashville Songwriters Association International.

<u>Jonas Lorence Band</u>

Over the years Jonas has been lucky enough to play with some of the best groups around including Lonely Child, The Dealers, Mark McKinney and the Cosmic Cowboys, the Stooch Band and The American Gypsy Band.

He loves the blues and is a big fan of Texas



blues guitar. Ever since he began playing guitar the blues has always been at the heart of what he does. Growing up on the coast has also become a big part of who he is. He loves the old Jimmy Buffett style of songwriting and hopes to keep that spirit alive.

Joneas wants to see Trop Rock music grow and become recognized from beach to beach across the globe. He plans on turning people on to new artists and making his own beach music for the rest of his life, and play live where ever he's invited to play.

But The Landsharks also do much more than just Jimmy Buffett and Beach Boys. The Landsharks have a VERY LARGE SONGLIST and play many other songs, artists, and styles of music, in addition to beach music.

Boomer Blake, Danny Rosado & Jonas Larence

Boomer Blake began building a Songwriting catalogue in college, but only made it a serious focus these last 10 years. His first single "Smooth Whiskey Weekend" was first played by Trop Rock DJ, Lyle Wilson on Radio A1A back in the Spring of 2016, and immediately hit the Weekly Trop 40 at #15! It topped out at #3 and stayed on the charts for 4 months till his next 2 singles "Livin' Loose in My Barefoot Shoes" and

"Escape for a Smile" took its place later that summer.

Since then, all of Boomers songs have had places on the Weekly Trop 40, the Shore Life Radio Top 20 Most Requested, and can be heard on multiple Trop Rock oriented Radio Stations.

Boomer can be found gigging solo along the Jersey Shore, nationally with fellow Singer/ Songwriter



Danny Rosado, as a call-in guest from time to time on Tiki Man Radio, or just Livin' Loose in his barefoot shoes with a rum drink in hand chillaxing at his favorite tiki bar!

Born and raised in the heart of the Tennessee Valley, **Danny Rosado** is a Trop Rock, Sandgrass, and Americana singer / songwriter from Huntsville, AL. Danny released his debut solo album, "Beach Boy Coming Home," in May 2017, and currently performs as one half of the Trop Rock duo, Danny Lowers the Boom. As a US Navy veteran and former Naval Aviator, Danny has developed a deep love and respect for the sea, and his songs reflect that.



Inspired by the musical sounds up and down the Florida / Alabama Gulf Coast, Danny first began to play guitar in 1996, after many a late night at the Florabama. Local legends such as Rusty McHugh and Mike Fincher, Jay Hawkins, Jezebel's Chillin' and the Southwind band were major influences during what would be considered his early formative years. The love

of the music went hand in hand with the love of the beach and the Gulf Coast vibe.

<u> Jimmy Parrish and the Ocean Waves</u>

In the beginning, the band mostly stayed close to home and performed around the Northeast Florida area. It wasn't until 2006 when they first started hitting the road. Their first visit to Meeting of the Minds was in 2009 where they performed on the main stage at the Casa Marina.

This is due of course to performing more out of town, along with exposing the Trop Rock nation to three albums of authentic original island music, Let's Go Fishin' (2007), Act of Piracy (2010), and I Need a New Island (2016). Songs like Where's the Tequila, Put a Little Hot Sauce On It, and I Need a New Island are in the regular rotation of most

all Trop Rock Internet stations.

Today, Jimmy Parrish & The Waves is considered one of the most requested headline acts in the country for major Parrot Head functions.

Thom Shepherd and Coley McCabe



In 2019 Thom Shepherd and Coley McCabe Shepherd are nominated in 14 categories between the Trop Rock Music Association (TRMA) Awards and the People's Choice Awards, including Entertainer of the Year, Duo of the Year, Songwriter of the

Year, Female Vocalist, Album of the Year, and Song and Single of the Year. The Lone Star Luau, their fourth annual Marble Falls, Texas-based music festival is nominated for Event of the Year at both Awards shows, and Thom will be taking on hosting duties at this year's TRMA Awards.

They were both working for Nashville publishing companies in the same building when they met. Today they are a fulltime traveling duo, singing songs that make people laugh and cry, everywhere from Key West to Seattle and abroad. Their latest duet project is called "SHOTGUN" and is available on iTunes, Apple Music, Spotify, and Google Play

Thom is the reigning TRMA Songwriter of the Year. Originally from St. Louis, MO, he is the writer of two number one country hits, "Riding with Private Malone" and "Redneck Yacht Club," three Texas Music number ones, has had over 100 songs recorded by other artists, two songs on Grammy nominated albums, and multiple top ten hits nationwide and in Texas. He is a former CMA of Texas Songwriter of the Year and appears in "The Parrot Heads Documentary" with Jimmy Buffett and the new independent film "Chasing The Sun." His song "Always Saturday Night" is played constantly on Radio Margaritaville.

Coley's song "Grow Young With You" was featured in the Natalie Portman / Ashley Judd film, "Where The Heart Is," and she co-wrote the top 5 Platinum-selling SheDaisy hit "Lucky 4 U." She hails from West Virginia and has had songs recorded by artists ranging from Bill Anderson to Loretta Lynn. She also starred in the film "Alabama Love Story."

The Corned Beef and Curry Band (CBCB) is a premier party band out of Pittsburgh PA. They have an uncanny ability to engage an audience and capture their attention. At a party or event, this means your group will



have "the best time ever". At a venue, this means they will keep the audience longer and run your register tape higher than most others. They are more than just excellent musicians, they are fun.

Although their core is Irish music from pure Celtic to rock, they have an amazing portfolio of songs from the 60's to current.

CBCB is a trio consisting of John McCann, lead singer and acoustic guitar; Bob Banerjee, harmonies, fiddle, and mandolin; and Brad "Hamish" Dindak on percussion, pipes, and the famous washboard.

Jimmy and the Parrots

Grab your beach chair, your suntan oil, and your favorite drink, and get ready for a trip to the islands with the ultimate tribute to Jimmy Buffett. For more than 12 years, Jimmy and the Parrots have been



playing to delighted crowds all over the United States as well as the Caribbean. Jimmy and the Parrots has been a featured act at the annual Meeting of the Minds Parrot Head conventions in Key West, Florida, for 15 years.. Their Key West performances also included well-known venues such as the the Smokin' Tuna Saloon, Rick's Café, Sloppy Joe's, Pat Croce's Rum Barrel, Schooner Wharf, and Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville. In January, 2005, over 80 fans traveled to Jamaica with the band for the first-ever "Yea Mon Tour" which included performances at Beaches Boscobel Resort as well as Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville in Ocho Rios. In February 2010, over 100 fans joined the band on their first-ever "Yeamon Cruise" which included performances on board the Carnival Pride as well as at Senor Frog's in Nassau, Bahamas. In July 2010, the band was part of the National Flagship Celebration for the SS United States, and plans call for Jimmy Maraventano's song about the ship—"Symbol of America" – to be included in the upcoming updated documentary "Lady in Waiting." In April 2011, they performed several times at the Atlantis Resort in Paradise Island, Bahamas. The band has two CDs of original tunes, "Better Than New" and "Back to the Bayou." In addition, they released (nationwide) a 30-song, three-CD set entitled "Island Jam." which has sold over 100.000 units to date. A second three-CD set entitled "Sun Jams," was released as a follow up to "Island Jam" which includes guest appearances by Jimmy Buffett's Coral Reefer Band member Doyle Grisham, the legendary Gary US Bonds, and other well-know trop-rock musicians. In March 2012, we once again set sail on Yeamon Cruise 2012 with over 100 fans joining the band on the Carnival Freedom where the band performed on board as well as at the Smokin' Tuna Saloon in Key West, FL. In November of that same year, the band was named "Entertainer of the Year" at the Trop Rock Music Awards held in Key West, FL, and honor which was repeated in November of 2014. Also in 2014, the band once again took over the high seas for "Yeamon Fun Cruise". The band performed on board the Carnival Splendor as well as in port at Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville in Grand Turk, Turks and Caicos. The band also traveled to the Four Seasons in Nevis. West Indies, in 2014 to perform for a corporate event. Our fifth Yeamon Cruise took place in April 2016, when we once again traveled with over 100 fans on the Norwegian Breakway to Bermuda, offering fans several performances on board. Plans are currently in the works for Yeamon Cruise 2020!

Jim Asbell and the Tropiholics

<u>Jesse Rice</u>

Jesse Rice is an award-winning writer and artist whose work has taken home numerous Awards. Most recently, this Billboard Top 40 charting artist was honored to see his co-penned song A Little Dive



Bar in Dahlonega featured on Ashley McBryde's Grammy nominated album Girl Going Nowhere.

Jesse, reared in the historic river town of Conway, SC about 15 minutes northwest of Myrtle Beach, moved to Music City in 2002 and began honing his songwriting skills while working at EMI Music Publishing. He would quickly network with rising artists and writers and secured his first publishing agreement in 2007 with Artist Revolution.

His first #1 came with the co-penned tune Cruise by Florida Georgia Line. It would go on to sell more than 10 million singles/downloads to receive the Diamond certification from the Recording Industry Association of America. It would also hold the record as Billboard's longest running #1 single for four years and took home ACM, AMA, CMA, Billboard, BMI and SESAC awards.

Jesse's songs have been cut by Florida Georgia Line, Nelly, Chase Rice, Kristian Bush of Sugarland, Ashley McBryde and Colt Ford. He's also co-written with top-talent like Lady Antebellum, Dan + Shay, Cole Swindell, Jon Pardi, Florida Georgia Line, Colt Ford and Chase Rice.

He launched the first installment of his "The Pirates Sessions" projects, The Pirate Sessions I & II, in 2012 featuring guest appearances by Florida Georgia Line and Chase Rice.

The Pirate Sessions III premiered in 2017 peaking at #5 on the iTunes Country Albums Charts. He would score a Radio AIA Trop Rock #1 with the lead single, Hangout with a Hangover. The second release, Hope Town, secured regular rotation on Sirius XM's Radio Margaritaville. The impact of this project not only secured him a performance slot at the 2017 Trop Rock Music Awards, but also resulted in him being award the "Horizon Award" at the ceremony.

Jesse carried on The Pirate Sessions legacy launching The Pirate Sessions IV in March 2019. The project, once again,

sailed Jesse inside the Top 10 on the iTunes Country Album Charts. He also notched his first solo project on the Billboard Country Album charts with a Top 40 "Hot Shot Debut" on April 1, 2019. The first release, Go Away Cloud, has spent multiple weeks at #1 on the Radio A1A charts.

James "Sunny Jim" White

Eight time Trop Rock Music Award winner James "Sunny Jim" White writes what he knows - his original songs are about love, life and the people who inspire him. He enjoys performing for purveyors of the island lifestyle. A versatile entertainer and musician, he is "living what he loves and loving what he lives." James has earned a loyal following across the



U.S. and the Caribbean with his original music and laidback style. Fans and friends alike enjoy his real-life experience and light-hearted approach.

Sunny Jim has been a regular on Jimmy Buffett's Radio Margaritaville, broadcasted on Sirius Satellite radio, since 1998. Sunny Jim is a four-time Trop Rock Music award winner; Vocalist of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010. He was named 2010 Musician of the Year. Sunny Jim's music is distributed by his own publishing company Laidback Lane Productions, Inc.

Heather's musical journey began at the age of 15 when her father bought her a Morris classical nylon string guitar. She began to jam with several friends, including her eldest brother. Heather was a quick study, and within a year she had begun taking lessons to improve her technique and develop her style. Heather attended

University of Northern Colorado as an exchange student. While in Colorado, Heather performed in an elite vocal jazz ensemble and had the chance to sing with performers such as Chick Corea, Sarah Vaughn, Richie Cole and Ed Shaughnessy. It was also during this time that she began to more seriously study classical guitar.

After graduating from college, Heather hit the road. She toured for three years with a successful rock band, Alter Ego. By 1985 Heather had become jaded by the music industry. The road, at the time, was just not for her. But at a private party in 1994, Heather was coerced into getting back on stage to perform with the hired band. Her musical spirit was reawakened, and she began performing with Breakheart Pass, a local country band. Heather and Dave met at a Central PA music festival in 1995, where each of their respective bands was performing. They formed Copper Sky in 1998, and their musical journey has continued ever since.

<u>Sauce Boss</u>

Bill "Sauce Boss" Wharton has brought his swampfunk, slide guitar-one-man band, and a pot of gumbo all across the US and to Canada, Europe, and Asia. Sauce Boss cooks gumbo while performing; serving up bowls to the audience at the end of the shows. He has served well over 200,000 people for free at his legendary live shows. Sauce Boss is the



guy Jimmy Buffett sings about in "I Will Play for Gumbo". Wharton's blues anthem, "Let the Big Dog Eat", has been covered by many, including Albert Castiglia. His version was #1 on the Roots Music Report for twelve weeks. The tune was also in Jonathan Demme's movie "Something Wild". Now, Bill's music will be featured throughout the soundtrack in the documentary, "Jimmy Carter - Rock and Roll President", debuting early in 2020.

John Frinzi & Aaron Scherz

A gifted singer and songwriter, skillful on both guitar and piano, **John Frinzi** has built an audience through craft and originality.

An early demo caught the ear of legendary steel guitarist



and long time Coral Reefer Band member Doyle Grisham, and their working relationship led to John's first CD, "Into The Dawn."

His second album, "Shoreline," showcases Frinzi's versatility as a songwriter and vocalist with many of the songs co-written by Tom Corcoran, co-writer of the Jimmy Buffett classics, "Fins," and "Cuban

Crime of Passion."

Most recently, John teamed up with multi-platinum Songwriter and Producer Aaron Scherz on their singles "Summer Sun" and "Lyin' or Lucky" which, in addition to being fan favorites on Sirius/XM, are included on their new album "Blue Sky View".

A seasoned live performer, Frinzi has toured nationally playing over 250 dates a year and has been featured at major festivals including the Keith Sykes Songwriters Celebration, Key West Songwriters Festival, Pensacola Beach Songwriters Festival and has shared the stage with acclaimed artists including Jesse Winchester, Mac McAnally, The Coral Reefer Band, Todd Snider and Maria Muldaur.

What do Al Jarreau, Madonna, Arrested Development, Janet Jackson & Jimmy Buffett have in common? The soulful vocal styling of Nadirah Shakoor! At the tender age of five, Nadirah told her parents she wanted to "be a singer like Diana Ross." Her family migrated from Texas to California where she studied commercial voice and went on to become one of the premier singers in Los Angeles and a much sought after back up singer for major tours.



In 1992, she joined the Grammy Award winning

Hip Hop group, Arrested Development as the featured vocalist and was nominated for a Grammy with the success of their 2nd album. Nadirah joined Jimmy Buffett's Coral Reefer Band as a back up singer in 1995.

<u>A1A</u>

The Official and Original Jimmy Buffett Tribute Show was born in 1991 when Lead Vocalist and Guitarist, Jeff Pike asked Atlanta Parrot Head Club Founder, Scott Nickerson to join him in his already successful one-man tribute to Jimmy Buffett. In 1992, the band won a Jimmy Buffett Sound Alike Contest for Margaritaville Records and the A1A ball started rolling – a ball that is still rolling 25 years later.

When attending an AIA performance you can expect to hear all of your Jimmy Buffett favorites. You will also be treated to some classic Reggae as well as some original AIA Trop Rock music. The energy, musicianship, originality, and excitement that have always surrounded an AIA performance is an experience and a driving force that has helped the band remain the first and foremost Jimmy Buffett Tribute Show in history.



<u>High South</u>

High South's origins stretch back to the early 2000s, when Garner and Mendoza met shortly after each had moved to Nashville. Interested in songwriting and influenced by '70s music, they were pursuing solo careers and trying to get discovered. Around the same time, Campos



was growing up in Los Angeles with an early desire to be a performer – one that led to singing background vocals on three world tours with Enrique Iglesias. It would take 12 years before Garner, Campos and Mendoza ever got in a room together playing guitars together and bonding with the harmonies of some of their favorite artists, such as Crosby, Stills & Nash and America; almost immediately, they realized they had created something special.

With impressive three-part harmonies, a dedication to songwriting, and unwavering optimism, the Nashvillebased band High South has developed a dedicated following across Europe, where they've been touring regularly there since 2015. Now they're breaking into the American market with A Change in the Wind, a captivating project that draws comparisons to classic rock bands like the Eagles, Doobie Brothers, and Crosby, Stills and Nash.

The Boat Drunks

From Champaign, Illinois and now entering their 19th year as a touring band and still going strong, The Boat Drunks have performed from coast to coast with nearly every member of Jimmy Buffett's Coral Reefer Band and have opened shows for Jimmy Buffett, The Beach Boys and Little Feat among many others. Other notable shows include playing outside of Wrigley Field in July 2011 prior to a Cubs-White Sox game, performing in 2015 at a Stanley Cup party for Coach Joel Quenneville of the Chicago Blackhawks, playing "Margaritaville" Theme Nights for the St. Louis Cardinals at Busch Stadium from 2016-19, for the Cleveland Indians at Progressive Field, at the United Center for the Chicago Blackhawks and for many other Margaritaville-sponsored events. Their set includes many fan-favorite Buffett hits, original music from their five studio albums and other covers ranging from Little Feat to Johnny Cash to The Beatles and more. The Boat Drunks perform at many "Parrothead"

fundraising festivals across the country and their originals have been heard on Buffett's Radio Margaritaville, Sirius/XM Channel 24 as well as many



other "trop-rock" radio stations and podcasts. Their latest album, released on March 9, 2018 and titled "Together We Fly", was produced by R. Scott Bryan (Devon Allman, Sheryl Crow, Peter Mayer) and features eight new original recordings written by the band. The first single from the album, titled "Beer, Buffett and Baseball" and penned by lead singer Mike Miller, has proven to be a hit with Parrotheads and baseball fans alike with its obvious nod to America's pastime.

SUNDAY Flip Flop Republic

The Flip Flop Republic is more than a band, it is an escape and the never-ending search of a good time! Their music will take you



away to your favorite beach, and their live show will make you forget vacation is almost over. Born on the beaches of the Gulf Coast of Florida, the Republic come together to create a great time for everyone at the coolest venues around the beach! Their sound reflects the spirit and energy of the gulf coast. Flip Flop Republic has toured all over the Southern US and Caribbean.

The Flip Flop Republic blend a heavy dose of reggae rhythm courtesy of drummer Miki Victor, who hails from the island of St. Maarten, and drummer Jake Pepple from New Orleans with rock influences brought in by lead vocalists Joe Lowder from Tupelo, Mississippi and Doug Dolan from Miami, Florida. The two singers split time in front of the mic, but rather than be singled out, the vocalists prefer to find harmony! Lastly, keyboardist Skinny B (Blake Bosarge) mixes in that bubble into the band's influences to provide the mix to create that rockin reggae sound.



<u>Barefoot Man</u>

"Caribbean islanders gave me the name Barefoot Man. They love to dress up, and shoes are important. Lack of shoes is a form of poverty.

"But it was natural for me. Why wear shoes? In my early performances in odd bars I played barefoot. So they called me Barefoot Man, No

Shoes Man, Barefoot Boy, and I ended up Barefoot or just 'Foot.

"The name has great commercial value. Can you imagine anyone on the island saying, 'Let's go see George Nowak?'"

When islanders and visitors come, they hear Barefoot's music. "It's like an island drink concoction: a mixture of calypso with a bit of reggae and soca, garnished with a little country and plenty of humor...put it in a blender and you dance to the beat."

<u>Mike Nash</u>

Mike Nash and Southern Drawl Band from Knoxville and Nashville Tennessee is "Southern Rockin' Country music with a twist of lime distilled in the backwoods of Tennessee." Mike Nash and Southern Drawl Band have been touring the U.S. from coast to coast since their humble beginnings in 2012."Tirelessly building our grass roots fan base from the ground up is the key to our success" says Mike Nash, frontman and guitarist for the band. "We have been honored to have won several awards for Band of the Year as well



as Entertainer of the Year beacuse of the support of our incredible fans who will regularly drive hundreds of miles for our shows and who have spread our message like wild fire".
