

Return to Work Criteria for Healthcare Personnel with Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19

Postive Test (with symptoms)	Positive Test (no symptoms)	Symptoms (no test)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resolution of fever (without fever-reducing medication) and• Improved respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath) and• Negative FDA Emergency Use Authorized molecular assay for COVID-19 (2 negative tests > 24 hours apart)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Exclude from work until 10 days have passed since date of first COVID-19 positive test (assuming they have not developed symptoms since their positive test)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath) and• At least 7 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
